

BBC Virtual Choir Directions

Thank you for your interest in helping produce BBC's very first *virtual* choir. The Lord is still on His throne through this difficult time, so let's acknowledge that and sing praises to Him! Follow these 6 steps to submit your recording to be a part of our virtual choir.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

1. Smart phone (or similar audio/video recording device)
2. A SEPARATE playing device for playback of the demo file (Maybe a family member's phone, or computer?)
3. Headphones for playback of the demo file

DIRECTIONS

1. Download or stream your voice part for "He Arose, Hallelujah" (soprano, alto, tenor, bass) for practice. You can access those files [here](#). (The password is **easter**.)
 - a. You can also download a PDF of the [printed music](#) for "He Arose, Hallelujah" and these [directions here](#). (The password for the music is also **easter**.)
2. Play the recording so you can hear it **through ear buds only** and recording yourself singing your part.
3. Record yourself (either video or audio only) with your smart phone or other device. Your recording should have only your singing voice on it; no other sounds.
 - a. Here is a video demonstrating [how to record](#).
 - b. Remember to be **absolutely silent** during all parts of the recording after you count (except for your singing). Wait **three seconds** after you finish singing before stopping the recording or speaking.
4. You may record yourself as many times as you like, but only submit one recording to Bro. Beck.
5. Here is a video describing [how to email](#) that recording to me from an Android phone or an iPhone.
6. All recordings should be emailed to Bro. Beck at dbeck@bbcwilmington.org by midnight, April 3, 2020. The title of the email should be your first and last name and "virtual choir".

This is an experiment for me and I don't know how long this will take, but I will share it with each participant once we are finished. Let's continue to fellowship through music even when apart!
